Our learning this half term:

- To follow our White Rose Maths scheme.
- Reading, writing and ordering numbers up to 100.
- Learning about place value (tens and ones).
- Solving calculations involving addition and subtraction.
- Immersing ourselves in our chosen texts - Paddington, Paddington at the Palace, Katie in London and non-fiction texts about The Great Fire of London.
- Writing non chronological reports about London Landmarks with headings and key vocabulary.
- Learning about "Uses of Everyday Materials"; identifying, naming, sorting and describing different materials and their properties.
- Drawing and painting Paddington and London Landmarks.
- Creating wheeled vehicles based on London transportation (red buses and black cabs) focussing on wheels and axels.
- Comparing our school to what schools were like in the past.

Ongoing learning:

- Individual and shared reading sessions
- Daily Phonics sessions
- Learning weekly spellings
- Handwriting - including pencil grip and letter formation
- Learn 2x, 3x, 5x, 10x tables off by heart.
- Writing a series of sentences independently using capitals, fingers spaces and full stops.
